Dear Readers,

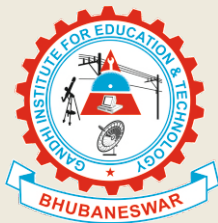

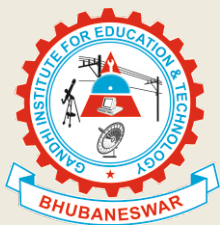

Nourishing Devotion At Puri

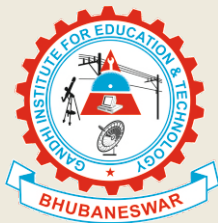

International Yoga Day 2025

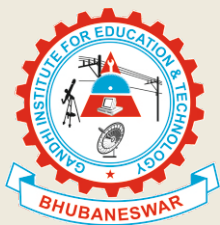

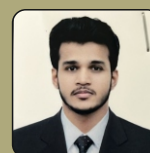
