Guidelines for Open Inter-University Debate Competition*

Debate Motion

"This House believes that Every citizen is a public health worker in the fight against mosquitoes."

Language

Participants may deliver their speeches in English, Hindi, or Odia.

Debate Format

Preliminary Round

Participants will be divided into groups of 6–8 speakers, depending on the total number of registrations.

Each group will include participants speaking For and Against the motion as far as practicable.

Each participant will:

- Deliver an individual speech of 5 minutes.
- Be asked one question by the judges (maximum 1 minute) to assess clarity of thought, subject knowledge, and spontaneous reasoning.

After all participants in a group have spoken, a moderated open interaction of approximately 5 minutes may be conducted.

Final Round

Finalists will present revised arguments before a common panel of judges. The final round will follow the same format:

- Five-minute speech
- One-minute interaction with the judges
- Moderated discussion among finalists

The judges' decision shall determine the winners.

Guidelines for the Open Inter-University Poster-Making Competition*

Theme

"Innovations and Community Action for the Prevention of Mosquito-Borne Diseases"

Poster Specifications

- Size: A2 (420 mm × 594 mm)
- Orientation: Portrait or Landscape
- Medium: Hand-drawn only
- Colour Medium: Water colours, poster colours, acrylics, oil pastels, colour pencils, sketch pens, charcoal, mixed media, or similar traditional art materials.

Not permitted:

- Digital artwork
- Printed posters
- AI-generated images
- Photographs pasted on the poster
- Pre-made templates or stencils
- Any copyrighted material without acknowledgement

Participants shall bring their own:

- Drawing board
- Colours
- Brushes
- Pencils
- Eraser
- Scale
- Other required stationery

The Organising Committee will provide:

- One A2 drawing sheet
- Seating arrangement

***Participants can participate in either of the competitions, not both.**
